2. Explain your colleagues the illustrated basic elements on the plan.

The floor plan

"Tittle block": Description of building and floor (at the lower right side)

• Block diagram: shows the property and assembly points

• Fire safety regulations "A" and behavior in emergencies:



Fire safety regulations A: What to do in case of fire (normally pictured or to find in Fire safety regulations)



What to do in case of an emergency situation (normally pictured)

Legend: Description of the icons

• Coloured point: marks the actual position (blue, orange, red or yellow)

• Fair green: floors which are the official escape ways/emergency exits

dunkelgrün:
 stairways which are the official escape ways (do not use elevators)

• Description of the icons at the ground plan: Where to find the *fire protection*— and *safety* equipment, e.g.

fire-extinguisher

wall hydrant/ fire hose

fire alarm box, manually operated

equipment for firefighting (e.g. fire blanket)

escape ways/emergency exits

assembly points

3. Guide your colleagues to assembly points



Follow the escape way(s), leave the building. On the way show your colleagues the equipment for firefighting and emergency. Tell (show) them how to use it.

4. Certificate of training



For documentation you have to sign the certification of fire and emergency training.
